## The End Times (part 8) The Real Rapture

What are you going to do tonight Pastor Vaughn? I don't know; I'm only going to teach against the biggest doctrine the Church believes in. Well, Glory! So tonight is part eight. We are going through the End Times series, and we told you that unless you understand the books of Moses, which is the Torah, that you cannot understand the end times, and I'm going to explain why tonight. This menorah I'm holding, sits in my home. It is beautiful. Yahweh, the God of Heaven, designed this. He told Moses how to make it.

What's so funny is that I saw all those Christians on TV, with ashes on their foreheads, and that's fine if you want to do that, do ashes. That's no problem. What is so funny though, is while they are sitting there with unbiblical ashes on their foreheads, they call me strange when I pull out a menorah, and yet this is biblical. Yahweh designed this. If you don't have one of these in your home, you might want to find one. They're inexpensive. It's a beautiful symbol of the end times.

You may say, "How does that represent the end times?" Well, how many branches to do see on there? Seven. How many days of a week? Seven. What day is the Sabbath Day? The Seventh. How many years does this represent? Seven thousand years. Yahweh when He built this, was giving you the prophetic message of when Yahshua is going to return. He is going to return on the Seventh Day. So if you don't understand the Holy Days, when you start teaching the end times, you're going to mess a lot of people up, you really are. Because you can't understand it outside of the Holy Days.

So tonight we are going to pick up where we left off. Last week, we brought you through the feasts, we brought you through Passover, First Fruit, Pentecost, and then we've been stuck on Trumpets for six weeks now. We've not left The Feast of Trumpets. Why? Because The Feast of Trumpets tells

us about the resurrection, and it took me six weeks to teach you about the different resurrections. So tonight we are going to move on. I wanted to move on to the next feast, which is Atonement, but I decided I can't go there tonight because there is a big wall facing the Christian Church, and it is The Rapture. I'm going to say this before I get started tonight: I grew up believing in a pre-tribulation rapture all my life. What is a pre-tribulation rapture? It says that before the tribulation starts, that you and I are all going to leave the earth, and we will not suffer the tribulation.

Can I ask you if that is pretty much what you grew up believing? Just a show of hands. That is the majority of what the Christian Church believes; that we are all waiting for the rapture. To prove that point, how many of you think this picture looks familiar? It's from the *Left Behind* series. I love you and I love everybody, but it was the biggest lie ever told, and the whole Christian Church fell for it. It's not because they're bad people. "But without knowledge," Yahweh said, "My people are destroyed." We walk around dumb and happy.

So that movie—I believe there were several parts of it—was a great money maker. Somebody got very rich off of a lie. And you want to know the funny thing? People don't mind that they lost money on a lie, but they'll get mad at me for telling the truth for free. They will. They're mad at me, and you ought to see the comments I'm going to get when they see this this video. Why? Because if you don't know the truth, here's what's going to happen: When we get to the resurrection, or to the Time of Trouble that is right on us, and they don't get their rapture, what's going to happen to the faith of those saints? They're going to lose their faith, and there's your great falling away, because there was no rapture of the Church.

Now this is what we've got to come against tonight, but we're not going to do it just to come against it. We're going to search the Scripture and we're going to see if there is going to be a pre-tribulation rapture. So, can I take a show of hands, without embarrassing anybody who's not been part of this ministry? Is there anybody here who would be honest with this class tonight and say, "Brother Vaughn, I believe in a pre-tribulation rapture."?

Anybody? You're confused. That's a good answer. Is it safe to say that up until this point, you have believed? Okay. So tonight I am not here to attack what you believe, because I was in the same boat with you, but I do want to know the truth, and I want to be ready one way or the other.

Now some folks say to me, "Brother Vaughn, I don't care when the rapture is; I just want to be ready." That sounds good, but here's the problem with that: the minute truth no longer means everything, is the minute it never means anything. So if you don't want to know truth, you don't want to know Yahweh, because the Bible said we should be watching and waiting. What;s going to happen when your money has no more value, and you can't buy a loaf of bread with a few dollars anymore because the tribulation has set in, and Jesus Yahshua has not come back? Satan is waiting for that moment.

Tonight when we look at these pictures on the screen, these are the most popular books of our generation. They were best sellers. They were best lies. They were good lies, and Yahweh's people bought it hook, line and sinker. Tonight's lesson is called *The Real Rapture*. Now, before we can proceed, we must establish our foundation, before we get into doctrine. Let's go read the book of Ecclesiastes 1:9, and then Isaiah 41:21-22. Before we can go any further, we must get the foundation right. Unless you get these two scriptures in your mind, you will be wrong.

By the way, so many of you have asked which Bible we use. I love *The Book of Yahweh*. It's the closest I've found to the original. It is an amazing Bible. I have tested them all, and this remains my favorite one. Let's read.

Ecclesiastes 1:9 That which has already been, will be yet again. That which has already been done, is what will yet be done again; there is nothing new under the sun.

Ladies and gentlemen, the first thing you need to learn about God, Yahweh, is that He never changes. You've got to learn that. You've got to know that. This verse just said that anything that's ever going to be, it already was. There is nothing new under the sun. What does that mean? How many of

you had an old grandpa or grandma, and you knew what they were going to do before they did it? You knew when they were going to get dressed for bed. You knew when they were going to have their coffee. You knew when they were going to watch Larry King, and when they were going to listen to Rush Limbaugh, God rest his soul. Why did you know them? Because you had watched them in their habits. They never changed. They were solid.

How many of you miss those grandparents that were rock solid, and you knew they were never going to change on you? My grandmother had the same phone number—736-6819—my whole life. Everybody else's number changed every day, but I knew that number would never change. There's a solidarity there in knowing that they never change. If you want to know what Yahweh's going to do in the future, all you've got to do is look back and see how He did it before. He never changes. There's nothing new under the sun. What shall be, has already been. History always repeats itself.

Isayah 41:21-22 Present your cause, says Yahweh: bring forth your strong reasons, says the King of Yaaqob. 22 Let them; who worship gods (elohim), bring them forth, and show us what will take place; let them show the former things—what they were, so we may consider them, and know the latter end of them; or declare to us things to come.

Here's what Yahweh said, "Do you want to know what the future is going to be? Bring forth the past." Let's read that twenty-second verse again. Read it carefully. If you want to know what *shall* happen, listen to what it says: *just show me the former things*. I'm teaching you some things tonight that will help you understand your Bible. Yahweh said, "If you want to know what the future is going to be, all I need you to do is to go dig up the past, and you can predict the future, because I don't ever change."

So when it comes to the subject of the Rapture, and the Coming of the Lord, we must find the patterns of Yahweh to know what's going to happen in our day. That's all we have to do. It really is that simple. When you get the foundation right, that's when you can begin to build good doctrine. There's

Moses standing up there on the mountain and he's got the Ten



Commandments in his hands. It was Moses who wrote about the Holy Days, which is what we're teaching up here. It was Moses who wrote about the Sabbath Day. It was Moses who wrote the secrets of the end times, and people didn't know he was writing about the end time.

Now if your end time doctrine is Pentecostal minister Irvin Baxter; I don't care, and I love him; God rest his soul. I don't care if it's Israeli televangelist Benny Hinn. I don't care who it is. If their End Time doctrine does not fit in these seven candles of our menorah, you'll get it wrong every time. Why? Because if it doesn't fit the prism and the understanding of the Holy Days, they will never line up with Scripture; they will never dovetail. Ever. They've got to dovetail with these Holy Days or they're not accurate. That's the bottom line. Remember, Yahshua always began explaining about Himself and His ministry. Where did He begin? In the Torah with Moses.

Who got the instructions for the menorah? Moses. Who explained to us about the Sabbath Day? Moses. Who explained to us about these Holy Festivals? Moses. If your End Time doctrine doesn't begin with Moses, you're on the wrong foundation. When they said to Yahshua,"Explain to us who you are," the Bible said He began with Moses. What's another word for Moses? Torah! Why? Because Moses wrote the Torah. So when you hear us talk about Torah, that's the same as saying Moses, basically. Every doctrine must begin in the Torah. The problem with the Torah is this: the New Testament preacher tells you that the Torah was done away with.

If the Torah is done away with, then you can teach anything you want to about the end times. You don't have anything to judge it by. Judgment begins with the Torah. It is in the Torah that Yahweh reveals Himself to us! Then Yahshua came, and He *was* the Torah in flesh. So we have to begin, not with a Bible seminary; we have to begin with Moses. Your End Time doctrine must begin with Moses. Now let's take another word from Moses and change it to the Holy Days. Why? Who taught us the Holy Days? See

what I'm saying? So when you say, "What do you mean, Moses?," I am talking about what Moses taught: the doctrines of Moses.

See those Holy Days in the image below? There's seven of them. There's seven Holy Days: Passover, Unleavened Bread—and by the way, we



will be celebrating these first two Holv Days April 6th and 7th at this church. We will be packed out, but we're going to be here; people will come from everywhere to celebrate the

Passover. HalleluYah. The next night we will celebrate the first day of Unleavened Bread. We will celebrate Pentecost in June, but all of these Holy Days have a message behind them. Passover is our Salvation. There's Sanctification, Filled With The Holy Spirit, the Coming of the Lord, The Binding of Satan, and The Millennial Reign, and The Eighth Day.

The reason your End Time doctrine is wrong is because you're not fitting it into those seven pictures; those Feasts. Nothing else will work but that picture. I want you to hear what I just said: Nothing else will work except that picture. Do you know why? Because Yahweh created that! They are His Seven Holy Days, and every one of them is laying out the Plan of Yahweh for the Ages. When the Church forgot these Holy Days, they lost their way

concerning the end times. The saddest thing we ever lost was the Holy Days, and it shakes me to the core.

Please don't take this wrong, my dear Catholic friends. I love you, but it never ceases to amaze me that there's not one scripture in the Bible that says to go put anything on your forehead. Nothing. There's not one. It's not in the Bible. And everybody on CNN thinks it's so cool that they're all walking around with these ashes on their foreheads. I'm fine with it, if you want to go do that. But is it not funny to you; does it not seem suspicious to you that any time we obey a scripture, we're weird, we're strange? Something's wrong with them, but you're walking around with ashes on your forehead! All we're doing is obeying the Word of Yahweh, but we're strange. You're walking around with a lump of junk on your forehead and you're going to look at us like we're weird.

I have a homework assignment for everyone in this room tonight. If you can point in your Bible to a scripture for every traditional Christian holiday that you keep, I will Paypal you whatever I've got left, because you can't do it. I can. I can go to a scripture that says, *You are to do this forever*, and it's the exact holiday that I keep. Until you can do that, who is a Bible believing Christian? Amen? AMEN! HalleluYah! Who is the Bible believing Christian? I can show you when Jesus Yahshua was born, and it wasn't on December 25th. It was during the Feast of Tabernacles. Oh yeah; but I'm weird. No, I'm Bible. Until you fall in love with doing it Yahweh's WAY, you'll do it Papa Pope's way every time.

But tonight we are a different people. We are set apart! And you know what? We're not even set apart from the world. We are set apart from the Church! It's not the world that makes fun of us. It's the Church that makes fun of us. It is Michael sitting up there mocking David. It is the Church that mocks us. But when you know that you're obeying Yahweh, that's all that matters. When you fall in love with Truth, they won't be able to keep you away from here. Why? Because Truth is Precious!! If you don't have truth, you have nothing. Nothing. You must have Truth! Why? Because there's coming a judgment when we're going to be judged by everything we've done

outside of the Word of Yahweh. I believe that. Tonight when we see the light, we've got to walk in it! Praise Yahweh!!

As you look at the image of the Seven Feasts, I want to ask you something. *Brother Vaughn, why don't you believe in a pre-tribulation rapture?*Because number one, look right here at number four: The Feast of Trumpets. That is the Second Coming of the Messiah. The reason I don't believe in a pre-tribulation rapture is because I don't see one in any of those Seven Days, those festivals. If Yahweh was going to give us one, He would have put another festival in there to represent the pre-tribulation rapture. The only festival we have there that's similar is the Coming of the Lord. If there was going to be a rapture, He'd have us celebrate it, but He didn't give us one. He said, "Celebrate My Second Coming; My First Coming and My Second Coming."

Now you won't see a rapture in there. In none of the Holy Days will you find a rapture. Why? Because none of the Church—and you can Google anything I'm telling you tonight—knew anything about anything called a rapture. Let's go back three hundred years ago. Let's walk into a church something like this one, a church of early believers, somewhere in the hills, and talk about a rapture before the Coming of the Lord. They wouldn't have known what you were talking about. Nobody had ever heard of a rapture. It was not even in the consciousness of the early Church. All they knew about was that fourth festival: the Coming of the Lord.

This theory of the rapture comes from a Catholic priest. You can Google his name: Manuel Lacunza. The first mention of a rapture comes from the Catholic Church. The priest Lacunza then met a Scottish clergyman by the name of Edward Irving. Irving was a member of something called the Plymouth Brethren. The Plymouth Brethren was a denomination like many of your denominations. They began to talk about this new revelation of a rapture. Then they met a man in America. His name was John Darby, an American Bible teacher among the original Plymouth Brethren. Anytime we find mention of the word rapture in America, it's from Mr. Darby.

There was a young boy that came to Darby's church, and grew up under his tutelage. That young boy was C.I. Scofield. If you've ever had a Scofield Bible, you know who I'm talking about. Mr. Scofield is the one who took Mr. Irving's teachings, and put them in the side notes of his Scofield Bible, and we act like that was inspired by the Holy Spirit. No, that was this man's interpretation of the end times. Everybody bought the Scofield Bible.

There was a man in Scofield's church by the name of Dwight Moody, a Massachusett evangelist, one of the most powerful evangelists in our history. It was Dwight Moody who took the message of the pre-tribulation rapture, and brought it all across the United States of America, and it took off like wildfire. Do you know why? Because people love escapism more than they do realism.

They want to get out of here. Nobody wants to see any trouble, but that's not quite what the Scripture teaches us. It may come as a shock to some who read these lines, but it is a fact that the rapture was not taught by the early Church. It was not taught by the first century Church. It was not taught by the Reformers. It was not taught by anyone until the year 1830. No rapture until then.

Now you and I claim to be Apostolic. Amen? Amen. *I'm Apostolic Brother Vaughn*. Then find me one apostle that caught a rapture, and we'll see how apostolic you are, because the apostles never taught escapism. No, they said that he who endures to the end will be saved. That's what the apostles taught. There's not one shred of biblical authority for a pre-tribulation rapture.

Here's what we're going to do now: we're going to go to the famous scripture that seems to support the rapture, and we're going to dissect it. The term *rapture* is not a biblical term, it is a theological term that many Bible teachers use to refer to a Greek word *harpazo*, which means *a catching away*. Let's go to I Thessalonians 4:17. Most of the Church has been taught the following: that when Christ comes, the dead will be raised

and immediately raptured to heaven, with the living saints close on their heels. But this is not what Moses and the Feast Days teach us.

As we have already seen, the Feast of Trumpets prophesied about the Resurrection of the Dead. But the Feast of Tabernacles talks about the Millennial Reign. So let's read how most people interpret this verse.

I Thessalonians 4:17-18 Then we who are alive *and* remain will be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet Yahshua in the air; and so will we ever be with Yahshua. 18 So in this way, comfort one another with these words.

Brother Vaughn, you're taking away the blessed hope of the Church. We're supposed to comfort one another with these words: that we're going to meet the Lord in the air, and there we shall ever be with the Lord. It's a beautiful verse, but until you understand it, it can be interpreted the wrong way. If I just take that verse, and I don't know the Holy Days, that verse seems to say that we're going to be caught up to meet the Lord in the clouds, and there shall we ever be with the Lord.

So what does this verse say? Let's examine the rapture verse. Notice what this verse does *not* say. It does not say that as soon as they are raised from the dead, they will be caught away. This has been assumed by those who don't know the Feast of Trumpets. Paul gives the order in which these events will happen, but he never says anything about the timing. In that verse, let's go through it one more time, and let me show you the order of it. Why does Paul not talk about the timing of all these things? He says we're going to meet the Lord in the air, and he's right. He says we are going to meet Him in the clouds, and he's right.

We seem to read that like we're going to WAKE UP, then MEET THE LORD IN THE AIR, and WE'RE GOING TO HEAVEN. But Paul doesn't tell you the timing of these things. Why not? I'm going to show you the answer. Go to chapter five, and read verse one and verse two, and you will see why Paul never deals with the timing of this.

5:1-2 But concerning the times and the seasons, brothers, you have no need that I should write to you. 2 For you yourselves know perfectly that the day of Yahweh so comes as a thief in the night.

Listen to what he said: I'm not going to talk to you about the timing of these things, because you know perfectly well, the timing. Who was Paul writing to? The Jewish people and the Gentiles that had come into Feast keeping. He said, "I'm not going to waste time here telling you how all this is going to time out, because YOU already KNOW! Why? Because you're a Feast keeper.

You know that after the Feast of Trumpets, is Atonement. Nobody is going anywhere until Tabernacles! Listen carefully now. Tabernacles is two weeks after Trumpets. What does Tabernacles represent? When we meet the Lord! Watch this carefully. Stay with me everybody. When we come up out of the grave, according to the scriptures we just read, it's poof, Poof, Poof: caught up, get up, and get out of here. But Paul said, "I'm not going to tell you about the timing of it because you already know. You're a Feast keeper."

What did we know? He's telling them that they know when this will happen, because he's telling them the Lord is coming at a day and an hour of which you know not. Do you know why he told them that? Because this next Feast—Trumpets—in Hebrew culture is referred to as *The Day That No Man Knows The Hour*.

What did Yahshua just tell them? "I am coming back at the Feast of Trumpets. You already know when I'm coming. so there's no need for Me to write it out in detail, because you already know." Oh, HalleluYah to Yahweh! I love what Paul said: "Now of the times; there's no need for me to talk about it." *Paul, why won't you tell us?* I won't have to if you keep the Feasts, because the timing is in the Feasts.

Everything is happening according to schedule. But Satan took these Feasts away from us—the Pope did. The Pope took them away from us so we wouldn't be watching and waiting. Oh, HalleluYah to Yahweh! Glory to Yahweh!

Let us rediscover certain laws about the Coming of Yahweh to mankind. Listen now. It's important that you get this. Remember, if it happened in the past, that's how it's going to happen in the future. So let's go read Genesis 2:22-24, and I'm going to show you a law of Yahweh that will never change. It will never change.

Genesis 2:22-24 Then the flesh and bone which Yahweh had taken from man, He made into a woman; and He brought her to the man. 23 And Adam said; This is now bone from my bones and flesh from my flesh; She shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man. 24 Therefore a man shall leave his father and his mother. and he shall be united to his wife (wives) in his own house, and they will therefore be as one family.

Wait a minute. Yahweh set a law, and I want you to listen to this law. The law is that the husband comes to the wife. The wife doesn't go to the husband. It never changes. He leaves his Father, and comes to the bride. We don't go anywhere. It's an irrefutable law! If that's the way it *was*, that's the way it always will be! You're not going to Him, darling. He will leave His Father, and COME TO YOU! It never changes! It's called the immutable patterns of God. What did Yahshua say? *I go to My Father, but I will come again to you*. Why? Because the husband comes to the wife; the wife doesn't come to the husband.

Ladies and gentlemen, He plans to come to us. You aren't going anywhere! And yet the whole Church believes they're going to meet Him and go to heaven with Him. *Brother Vaughn, He said, "I'm going away to prepare a place for you."* That is not what He said, and I don't have time to explain it tonight. But listen, the only place He is preparing for the bride is the same place that the first Adam prepared for the first Eve: the garden of Eden,

right here on Earth! HalleluYah! Remember what we read in Isaiah. He said, "If you want to know how to do it in the future, look at how we did it in the past, and it will never change."

Let's talk about another one. Let's talk about a little man named Noah. Yahweh said, "I'm about to pour out My wrath and destroy the earth." *Then we better get ready to get raptured out of here*. "Oh Noah, no need for that, because I'm going to put you in a protected boat, and while I'm pouring My wrath out, you are going to be protected right here on Earth." If that's how He did it for Noah, who do you think you are?! *Brother Vaughn, I'm special*. Honey, Noah was a *friend* of Yahweh. How much more special are you?

He didn't rapture Noah. He PROTECTED Noah! And what about the next little guy? Do you remember a guy named Lot? When Yahweh began to pour out wrath on Sodom and Gomorrah, what did Yahweh do with Lot? Did He rapture him out of there? No. He protected Lot. Yahweh poured out His wrath the same yesterday, today, and forever!! In the book of Revelation at the Seventh Seal, He said, "Go forth and put a seal on the forehead of My people, and you make sure that they are not harmed. Protect them." There was nothing about escaping out of here, but they're going to be protected.

Let's go over to the land of Egypt. There is Yahweh's little church living in Egypt, and here comes the plagues of Yahweh upon the Earth. What does He do with that little church of His? Does He rapture her or does He protect her? He is the same yesterday, today, and forever. I NEVER CHANGE!

In AD 70, when Yahweh looked at the children of Israel, He said, "There's trouble coming. There's going to be a destruction of Jerusalem like you've never seen." He said, "Pray that when that destruction comes, it doesn't happen on the Sabbath Day. You pray, and then you run to the mountains. When you get to the mountains, I'm going to protect you." That's exactly what happened. Why didn't Yahweh rapture them? Were they not special? I

read about a God that is no respecter of persons, but He's going to rapture you?

I'll tell you what He does in the midst of trouble. Do you know that you have practiced this thing many times in your own life? When even the wrath of Yahweh was poured out all around you, there was a protection over you, that protected you from even the diseases of the land. Yahweh is a protecting God! You better learn this, or you'll keep looking for the rapture, instead of the covering of the Almighty God. Because when trouble comes, you're going to try to find a way out. You better find a way into the wings; the shadow of the wings of the Almighty Yahweh. He said, "If you abide in Me, and if I abide in you, then you will be safe."

Now there's one thing we will not be protected from. There is going to be seven years of trouble on our planet. Some of you in this building will not survive the first three and a half years. That's the Antichrist's wrath. There's no protection there for you. The Bible said that many of you *will die, for My Name sake,* during that time. But when Yahweh's wrath takes over; three and a half years of His wrath, the Bible said a third of the earth will be destroyed. When that happens, you are going to be protected from His wrath. You will be sealed during that time, and if you don't get this message, you are going to be a falling away saint when you don't see the Rapture of the Church.

You better know the truth tonight. Remember, He's coming to you. He's coming to you; you're not coming to Him. He's coming to get you. HalleluYah. Now let's look in the Torah real quick, and see if we can't find the patterns of the Comings of Yahweh. Watch this carefully with me. In the Torah, let's read Exodus 19:18-20. Now I want you to listen, because remember, everything starts with Moses.

If you want to understand Yahshua, Moses said that Yahshua would be like him, didn't he? He said, "A prophet will rise up like me." So if you want to understand Yahshua, you better understand Moses. I want you to hear something now that's going to make you want to put your shouting shoes on. Remember, however He did it in the Torah, is how He is going to do it in our day.

Exodus 19:18-20 Now Mount Sinai was completely engulfed in smoke, because Yahweh descended upon it in fire;

Hold on. Yahweh, what? Yahweh is descending. He's coming down.

and its smoke ascended like the smoke of a furnace, and all the people trembled greatly, 19 And when the sound of the shofar sounded long, and became louder and louder, Mosheh spoke, and the voice of Yahweh answered him by voice. 20 And Yahweh came down upon Mount Sinai, on the top of the mountain; and Yahweh called Mosheh to the top of the mountain, and Mosheh went up.

Okay. Do you know what we have right here? We have the first coming of the Lord. You better watch this. You better see the way He did it for Moses. How He did it for Yahshua is how He's going to do it for you. He came DOWN. Then what did Moses do? The Bible said Moses went up just a little ways. Oh yes, we're going up, but you better follow this pattern. Moses went up to meet the Lord in the air, on that mountain. What is the *air*? You're breathing it, right here. Moses went up a little ways. He didn't go to heaven. He went up to meet the Lord. And guess what happened when he started to go up? A trumpet sounded. Does that sound familiar to anybody?

The trumpet sounded, and Moses, representing the Church, went up to meet the Lord in the cloud, because the cloud was on the mountain. The Bible said the cloud came down. *Brother Vaughn, it said we're going to meet Him in the clouds*. Baby, I met Him in the clouds tonight. Where were you? The cloud came down. Did you hear me? The cloud came DOWN tonight. Moses went up a little higher, and he went into the cloud, and the trumpet sounded. And the Bible said there Yahweh spoke with him, and Moses went UP.

I want to compare these passages. We aren't going to read them, so you don't have to turn there. But let's compare Exodus 19:18, to I Thessalonians 4:16. You might see where Paul was getting his doctrine from, about the second coming. Exodus 19:18 says the Lord descended. Yahweh descended. What did I Thessalonians 4:16 say? The Lord Himself will descend from heaven. Your Bible is perfect, children, from Genesis to Revelation. It's PERFECT. There is no mistake in the Word of Yahweh. *But we were taught the people are going up*! No. In every case, the Lord came down!!

Now let's compare Exodus 19:19: The sound of the trumpet grew louder and louder. I Thessalonians 4:16: The voice of the archangel and the trumpet of Yahweh. Do you think Paul was reading about Moses, maybe? And then Exodus 19:20: Moses went up. I Thessalonians 4:17: The saints were called up together. See? It all begins with Moses.

Let's look at another Coming of the Lord in Exodus 24:13-18. When you see these patterns of the Coming of the Lord, you will wonder where we came up with our pattern from, that we're all getting out of here somewhere.

Exodus 24:13-18 Then Mosheh set out with Yahshua his assistant, and Mosheh went up on the mountain of Yahweh. 14 He said to the elders; Wait here for us until we return to you. Truly Aaron and Hur are with you. If anyone is involved in a dispute, let him go to them. 15 Then Mosheh went up into the mountain, and a cloud covered the mountain. 16 And the glory of Yahweh rested upon Mount Sinai and the cloud covered it six days. And on the Seventh Day Yahweh called to Mosheh out of the midst of the cloud. 17 To the eyes of the children of Israyl, the sight of the glory of Yahweh looked like a consuming fire on top of the mountain. 18 And Mosheh entered the midst of the cloud as he went on up the mountain; and he stayed on the mountain forty days and forty nights.

In this story, Moses talked to Joshua—the Hebrew word for Yahshua—and if you read verse thirteen, Moses is talking to Yahshua, and the Bible said

Moses arose as it were, from the dead, and went up to the mountain of Yahwheh. And before he went up to the mountain, he turned to the elders and said, "Wait here until I come back." Do any of you remember somebody else saying that? Yahshua said, "I'm going up to my Father. Wait here until I get back." Whooo hoooo HalleluYah! And then, Moses ascended to the mountain and remained there forty days. Remember, everybody thought he was dead because *he had gone in to give us a symbol*.

What is the symbol? Forty Days. If you take the forty Jubilees by forty-nine years, that will give you two thousand years. Moses went on the mountain with Yahweh for two thousand years! Hold on children! It's about to get good over here if you've got spiritual ears!

Remember, however it happened in the Torah, is how it's going to happen now! He told Joshua, "I'm going up to see my Father, but I want you to wait for me." Then the Bible said he went up. He didn't go up for ten days or twenty days. He went up for forty Jubilees, which is forty-nine years for each Jubilee, and that's a symbol of TWO DAYS, or two thousand years he was on the mountain with his Father!

And when you read those five verses, you're going to find out that over in Hebrews 7:25, it says that Yahshua went to His Father in Heaven, and He's been sitting on that mountain for about two thousand years, and we're still waiting at the bottom of the mountain for Him to come back and keep His word!!

I don't know how anybody goes to church and they don't learn these things. This is LIFE, children. I watch people listen to me, and some people are just sitting there, and I want to say, "Do you understand you're getting the words of Life in this ministry?!! Do you understand that truth is being unfolded before your blessed eyes? That your Bible is being made PERFECT before you? That Satan cannot trick you up? "

You're being protected by the Truth!! This ought to be of more value to you than anything in your life. So many people tonight are wandering in

darkness waiting on this mystical rapture, and Yahweh's Church is getting ready for Trouble. We're getting ready to Overcome. We're getting ready to fight every Battle. We're getting ready to know He's going to Protect us though the storm. Whooo HalleluYah! But Satan will come to the majority of the Church when the tribulation starts, and say, "Do you still believe?" They'll respond, "No." *Why?* "It must all be a lie."

Moses is a type of the Overcomers. HalleluYah. Now listen to this in Exodus 24:16. I'm going to show you something. Remember the way He did it in Torah is how He's going to do it again. Oh, but I forgot, Yahweh did away with the Torah. That's why you're messed up with your walk with Yahweh. You think that's all been done away with.

## Exodus 24:16 And the glory of Yahweh rested upon Mount Sinai and the cloud covered it six days. And on the Seventh Day Yahweh called to Mosheh out of the midst of the cloud.

For six days, Moses sat in that. This is another *going up*. The first time it was for forty days. This time it's for six days. There's a message here. The message is Moses came into the cloud, and on the Seventh Day, Yahweh called Moses to do what? Come up the mountain on the Seventh Day. Watch me: For six days, we've all been waiting in the cloud. We've gone down to the altar, we've felt the cloud, we've been in the cloud, we've spoken in a heavenly language, we've drank from the cloud, we've been in that cloud just like Moses was for six days. But on the Seventh Day, Yahweh told Moses, "Come on up the mountain now. I'm ready to meet you in the air!!"

My God; I feel like shouting in this church tonight!! Come on OUT Moses! It's the Seventh Day! That's why I have fought in this town for seven years to promote the Seventh Day. I'm not trying to start a new religion. I'm not trying to be different. I'm trying to teach you the beauty of the Seventh Day; what's going to happen on the Seventh Day when the dead in Christ shall RISE! Why do you think that brother Ricky Ezra blows that trumpet every Friday night? Why do you think he sounds it? We're practicing. We're

practicing for the Seventh Day when the dead in Yahshua SHALL RISE with a Shout!!

I have had to fight Hell to get this Seventh Day message out. I have fought the people that I love, who don't understand my message. This isn't about salvation. This is about the Coming of the Lord Yahsha Messiah, on the clouds of glory. Are you ready?!! Are you watching? Are you waiting? Are you preparing your loaves? Oh! Holy Ghost! Satan hates this Seventh Day message. He hates it. Just like he hated the Yahshua Name message in baptism, he hates this Seventh Day message. Why? It's bringing us closer to the Coming of the Lord.

Are you ready for what's about to happen on this planet? The Seventh Day is upon us. We are people of the Seventh Day. I hope you heard me. We're the PEOPLE of the SEVENTH DAY! That's why we're here tonight. We're not here because we want to have church on a weird day. I could be home in my recliner! But there's going to be a recliner like you've never seen!! It's going to pop you up, and shoot you out. You're going to meet the Lord right in the middle of the air! Are you ready for what's about to happen?

For over two years, my wife and I, my mother-in-law and my father-in-law, and maybe one or two at the back would come here on a Friday night. Nobody was here for the message. Most of you here tonight weren't here then. But we were holding up the banner, waiting for you to hear it. We wouldn't give up. We wouldn't stop, because this is the LAST DAY message: The Seventh Day is upon us!! You've got to have a backbone of STEEL for this message. HalleluYah!

There's not going to be a rapture. Then why does it say we're going to meet the Lord in the air? We read it in I Thessalonians 4:17. This is the first thing people will say when you tell them there isn't going to be a rapture. They'll point to this scripture. They don't understand. If you call me and say, "Pastor, I want you meet me at Walmart; I want to give you something," and you live over in the Kiln; just because I meet you in Walmart doesn't

mean I'm going to the Kiln with you. I'm coming right back from where I met you.

Hold on. Watch this carefully. The Greek word *to meet in the air* is the Greek word *apantesis*. You've got to get this! Do you know what it means? It describes what the town leaders did when a very important person was coming to visit them. They would send a welcoming delegation to meet him. But the delegation that meets the dignitary doesn't go home with the dignitary. They bring the dignitary to their house.

Listen to me. In those days, *to meet* simply meant that you were from another country, and that maybe a prince or a king, and you were coming. The town leader said, "Now we want you to go and MEET that king out there in the field," but they didn't mean for you to go HOME with the king. They meant for you to escort the king to your town, to your home. We are meeting the Lord to escort Him back to our home!

Do you remember when Isaac saw Rebecca? I preached a message here one time called *Ride Rebecca Ride*. Do you remember that the Bible said Isaac went out to the middle of the field to meet her? She met him, and then they went home together!

When that stallion kicks back a dust cloud coming from the galaxies of heaven, and we rise from the dead and we see the Lord, there's going to be magic in our slippers. We're going to have an ability to run with a strength we never had, to meet the Lord in the air, and to come back with the Lord! And then shall we EVER BE with the Lord! HalleluYah!!

When you fall in love with Truth, you'll do the same thing! Go on out there; go out and meet the mailman, but don't go home with him! Make him bring the mail up to the house. Listen to me. We are going to be that delegation that escorts our Husband home. We're going to be displayed. When Yahshua returns, He'll bring us with Him. How? Because we're going to meet Him.

Once we meet Him, that's where people get confused in the Bible when they read that when He returns He will bring us with Him. We automatically think that means He is bringing us to heaven. No, no, no. The reason He is going to bring us with Him, is because we ran out there and met Him. And then, after we shake hands with Him, and after we meet Him face to face, then He is going to say, "Are you ready? Let's go back to Earth!" And the Mount of Olives, it's going to split; it's going to split in two! We will be there with Him!

And the devil's preachers have got you wanting to meet Him, and going to His house that He came from. That's not the way it works. We are coming back to EARTH to go to work. Oh yes! We are coming back with Him because He's got work to do for a thousand years. Do you know what He's got to do? He's got to kick some devil butt. He's coming back to kick a thousand years of devil butt. He's coming back to put every demon power under His authority! He's coming back to set into position, sons of Yahweh who are going to take over the Dominion on this earth. You're not going anywhere! You've been lied to.

Do you know what that Spirit will do? Listen to me carefully. It will drive religious spirits in this house insane! Did you hear me? Those demons in your mind will drive you insane because you don't mind hearing a football game and that kind of stuff, but when it comes to truth, it bothers you. I've got your number! If you don't love truth, that will bother you; but if you love truth, it will turn you on! HalleluYah! Glory to Yahweh!

I want to explain something. This ministry has two parts to it. Please listen to me, because right now I feel like I'm fighting Hell itself. You listen now. This ministry has two parts to it and you better get this straight. The first part is TRUTH. I've spent seven years teaching Truth. But there's another side called SPIRIT. It's about to bust loose in this church. Do you hear me? It's about to BUST LOOSE in this ministry!! When you put them both together, that's the POWER of Yahweh!! The Word of Yahweh is more powerful than a Sword! HalleluYah to Yahweh!

We need both of them! When you sacrifice Spirit for Truth, you wind up with a dead church. When you sacrifice Truth for Spirit, you wind up with an emotional church. But when you bring them both together, you've made an army that the devil is not ready for. Waveland, Mississippi is not ready for Spirit and Truth: the outpouring of the Holy Ghost, with the outpouring of Truth!! HalleluYah to Yahweh!

HalleluYah to Yahweh! There's a change happening. There's a CHANGED church; there's a change happening. I hope you're ready for it. It won't look like what it used to look like anymore. It will be the coming together of the roots of Pentecost, and the roots of Truth, moving together the Power of Yahweh with the Word of Yahweh. It's a Power that together Waveland is not ready for, when you walk in Truth.

I feel so much Power. HalleluYah to Yahweh. I will not be held back by anybody or anything. We've given our Life, and every one of you who's still with me, we have given our life to see this come to LIFE. Don't let the enemy steal this from you. This is precious. This is what Yahweh is doing right now! What's about to explode is a hydrogen bomb of Truth and Spirit. Glory to Yahweh. I want everyone in this church to begin preparing for signs and wonders, and miracles from Yahweh. Do you know why? We've been faithful to Yahweh. We've been faithful to Truth, and the honor comes from the Lord Himself. HalleluYah.
