JOY COMES IN THE MORNING Part 8

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This is part eight of Joy Comes in the Morning and for those who are just joining us for the first time, First Harvest Ministries has been teaching for eight weeks now what God's plans are for all of humanity.

The church has told us what his plans are, but those plans do not line up with the word. And so we had been trying to show you that there's coming a wonderful day, a joy-filled day, whenever Yahweh is going to bring healing to planet earth, and that's why I preach so hard against climate change because it's demonic. Climate change is demonic. It is an agenda of hell.

Do you know I found out yesterday that in 1982 the temperatures we're having right now are still one degree lower than they were in 1982? And they've lasted for twice as long as they've lasted this year. So I've been preaching against climate change because climate change basically says that Yahweh is not in control, that man is. And that man is about to destroy our planet when the word of Yahweh says the total opposite.

The Bible says... we have seven verses that I can quote you that the earth will never be destroyed. So if I've got Al Gore over here telling me the earth is going to be destroyed, and I've got Yahweh over here telling me it's not, I have to choose who I believe. I believe Yahweh has a better track record than Gore. And so I choose to stand with truth. Amen.

What's happening right now in our world is we're winding up the sixth day. We're winding up the 6,000th year. All of these things are bringing us to a wonderful morning that is about to dawn on planet earth. And in that day that's coming, everyone who has ever not been called like you have into this glorious light—they will be called on that great day.

And so your family and your lost loved ones that you're so worried about—your worry is in vain. You see, it is a trick of the enemy to want you to be so focused on who's not saved that you don't focus on perfecting yourself. Because you and I have nothing to do with the salvation of mankind. You and I can draw no one to the Father. Only the Holy Spirit can do that. So it troubles me when I see people out, you know, doing the work of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

So today we're going to pick up on that. If you're new here and everything I've just said sounds foreign to you, I don't blame you. You need to test everything by

the word. We have seven parts you can go watch to this series and we'll lay it all out for you. Joy does come in the morning. So we're picking up there today. A lot of people I'm noticing are confused about the two resurrections. So real quickly I'm going to make it so simple that hopefully all your confusion will leave quickly.

Here's the simple facts. There are two resurrections. Christians do not come up in the first resurrection. Sinners do not come up in the first resurrection. Both the Christian and the unbeliever remain in their graves until the second resurrection. The second resurrection does not happen until the end of the 7th day. The first resurrection happens at the beginning of the 7th day.

Who comes up in the first resurrection? Only the government. Only the sons of Yahweh, not the servants of Yahweh, but the sons of Yahweh. Only the fullyadopted comes up in the first resurrection. I don't know if it'll be 60- and 100fold, how it's going to happen, but I do know that the 30-fold believer will not come up till the second resurrection, maybe the 60-fold as well. But the 100-fold believer will come up in the first resurrection.

The Christian church has not equipped you for that first resurrection. Do you know why? They know nothing about it. And therefore, they're trying to get you saved when the Father is so over salvation. It's such a childish subject because the purpose is not salvation. The purpose is preparing you for the first resurrection.

I want to prove that to you in Titus 3:8. Let's see what our duty is after we have been saved. Now I use that word very loosely because we know that no one is saved at this moment. The better word is "converted". Since you've been converted or redeemed.

Titus 3:8

This is a faithful saying, and these things I will that thou affirm constantly, <u>that they which have believed in Yahweh might be careful</u> <u>to maintain good works</u>. These things are good and profitable unto men.

The church you and I grew up in teaches you that works have been done away with. There are no works involved. Then I need someone to explain that verse— I'm willing to be corrected, but I need someone to explain that verse that tells me the purpose of my salvation (redemption) is to maintain good works.

Now why is it important for me to maintain good works? The first resurrection. Because we know that in the first resurrection you will not be judged according to your faith. No, you will not be judged according to whether you believed in your head, but you will be judged according to your works. That's in your Bible. You can go find that in the book of Revelation. It's very plain. He said...I know thy works, you who have kept my works, you will be rewarded for your works. Revelation 18:6, 20:12. I saw the dead, small and great, stand before Yahweh, and the books were open, another book was open which is the book of life, and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books... ACCORDING TO THEIR WORKS. Revelation 20:13. And the sea gave up the dead which were in it, death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them.

Now right there, let me stop and pause. A lot of people read that verse and say... you see pastor, you preach that no one's in hell right now, but it says in Revelations 20:13 that death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them. But brothers and sisters, don't be deceived. That word HELL, if you would just click on your concordance there, you'll find out that that is not hell. That word there is the Greek word Hades which simply means the grave. The grave gave up the dead.

But do you see how you'd just read that and automatically think my teaching is false because it says "hell gave up the dead"? But it's not the "lake of fire". Hopefully next week I'm going to teach, and maybe today start on the "fire" part, but next week we'll really get into it. I'll teach you about the 3 hells so you know when you're reading your Bible that hell doesn't always mean hell. That is very important.

It's important that you understand the first resurrection. Why? Because you did not understand before in your Christian life, and that's what's robbing you of being an overcomer. Because your entire Christian mindset is what? Get saved, go to heaven. That mindset is anathema to works. If that is your mindset, you reject the message of works. You think it's just "the finished work of the cross" and you buy into that deception. My job is to deliver you from deception so that you will come up in the first resurrection. Give me a high-five and say thank you pastor for teaching me what my opportunity was to rule and reign with Yahshua over the nations of the earth. That is where you have got to change your thinking in the two resurrections.

Those that come up in the second resurrection will not be in the government. There are several synonymous words with the government. When I say those words in my teaching, I don't want you to be confused. So let me tell you—when you hear me say "government" — there is another word that is the same. The bride. When you hear me refer to the bride, that's the government. When you hear me refer to the New Jerusalem, that's the government. All of these words are encapsulating the same mindset…overcomers. When you hear me say the word overcomers, that's the government. So everything in my preaching is about the first resurrection, I couldn't care less about the second resurrection because the Bible tells us to earnestly desire (let me pull it up for you...none of this was planned so I'm over here looking up verses as I talk, ha! ha!). Hebrews 11:35. This should be your goal. Hebrews 11:35 should be your goal as a believer.

Hebrews 11:35 Women received their dead raised to life again: and others were tortured, not accepting deliverance; <u>that they might obtain a better</u> <u>resurrection.</u>

Did you say there's a better resurrection brother? Did anybody read that? Brother, there's a better resurrection. All your life you thought there was a resurrection. Amen? Amen. You thought there was <u>A</u> resurrection. We're teaching you about a *better* resurrection. *That's what they teach you—is just a resurrection*. But the Bible says there's a BETTER RESURRECTION.

Now it's talking about the women receiving their dead to life. Why don't we read the verses above it. Let's find our context there.

Hebrews 11:32-35 32 And what shall I more say? for the time would fail me to tell of Gedeon, and of Barak, and of Samson, and of Jephthae; of David also, and Samuel, and of the prophets.

Ok, I get it. So here's our context. Paul is giving us an illustration of who? Overcomers. Hallelujah. Paul is giving us a list of people who have earned a better resurrection. Keep reading...

33 Who through faith subdued kingdoms, wrought righteousness, obtained promises, stopped the mouths of lions,

34 Quenched the violence of fire, escaped the edge of the sword, out of weakness were made strong, waxed valiant in fight, turned to flight the armies of the aliens.

But why did they do that? Why were they willing to do all of this? Why were they willing to shut the mouths of lions and be eaten by lions? Why were they willing to take the sword? Why where they willing to do this? Because they were not Christians, oh hallelujah! They had not bought into the Christian lie that their job was to be saved. They were fighting for what? That better resurrection! Folks it's right here in your Bible. I don't make this stuff up. Keep reading...

35 Women received their dead raised to life again...

Women were willing to let their husbands and children be killed for the gospel's sake. They were willing to give up everything.

...and others were tortured...

People were willing to be tortured. They're not looking for a rapture. They were not looking for an escape route. They were not looking to go to heaven. They were looking to suffer so that they might...read it...

...not accepting deliverance...

They didn't even want a rapture! Is anybody hearing me? They didn't want to escape this life. They didn't want to escape the trouble, the persecution. Your whole Christian mindset was conditioned to not have to suffer! Your whole Christian mindset was "God doesn't have wrath for you". God's going to get you out of here. But you see, if he does, you're going to miss out on what? ...

...that they might obtain a better resurrection.

Your job is to obtain a better resurrection! That's your job saints!! That's the job nobody told you about. I want to see what that word *obtain* means. *Tugchano* in Greek. Attain, secure, enjoy, take, reach...a better resurrection. Hallelujah. So brothers and sisters, your job is to forget about the second resurrection. That is so not your calling. Your calling is to suffer! Amen. Hallelujah.

There were works involved in all that. There were works in obtaining what? A better resurrection. The problem is Christians don't want a better resurrection. They want to go to heaven. It's not in my notes either, but I might as well read what Paul said. Philippians 3:12-14. (by the way the lesson has not started yet)

Philippians 3:12-14

12 Not as though I had already attained, either were already perfect: but I follow after, if that I may apprehend that for which also I am apprehended of Messiah Yahshua.

13 Brethren, I count not myself to have apprehended...

Now listen. This is Paul talking about this better resurrection, the first resurrection. Now Paul is saved, filled with the Holy Spirit, and what does he say right there? He said...something has apprehended me. What apprehended him? Yahweh. Yahshua the Messiah apprehended Paul just like he apprehended you. He apprehended Paul on the road to Damascus like he apprehended you on the road to hell. He got you. But Paul said...even though he's apprehended me, I do not consider that I have grabbed hold of that which has grabbed hold of me.

...but this one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind, and <u>reaching forth unto those things which are ahead</u>,

Paul said there is something that he is reaching for. If Paul is saved, what is he reaching for? A better resurrection. What does he call it?

14 I press toward the mark for the prize of <u>the high calling</u> of God in Messiah Yahshua.

So evidently there is a "calling" and then there is a HIGH CALLING. So there's a resurrection and there's a "better resurrection". There's a calling and a high calling. And Paul says that he does not know if he will apprehend the high calling. Brothers and sisters, your job in this life, once he has apprehended you, is for you to apprehend the high calling. Is everybody with me? Amen. You must apprehend the high calling brothers and sisters. And when you do that, when you apprehend the high calling, then you will be counted worthy of a better resurrection. Amen.

Alright. Let's go into the lesson now. We'll get started where we left off last week. We were talking about the 100-year judgment whenever we left. When we were reading about the 100-year judgment, the overcomers that would be judged by the son, let's read 1 Corinthians 6:2, then we'll move into today's lesson.

1 Corinthians 6:2

Do ye not know that the saints shall judge the world? and if the world shall be judged by you, are ye unworthy to judge the smallest matters?

So the saints are being judged right now. The world will be judged by who? The saints. Now brothers and sisters, we have a major issue here. The Christian church teaches us not to judge. The Christian church says we're not supposed to judge, correct? So can someone tell me how we're going to fulfill our obligation of judging the whole world? Do you know why brothers and sisters?

If we're training for reigning, and we know that we're going to be judging the world, Paul says we should start doing that judgment in the church. Judgment begins where? In the what? In the house of Yahweh. You see, we always thought that meant that judgment was coming to the house of Yahweh. No, no, no.

Judgment begins with us because we must be trained how to judge so that we can judge the whole world.

Now that is an idea that is foreign to Christianity. What is the first thing that you will ever hear in a Christian church? Judge not. Do not judge. That is demonic. If you hear anyone tell you...don't judge...you are literally listening to a demon rob you of your entire life calling. Discernment, judgment, begins with us. And we must all be willing to hold ourselves accountable to the judgment of the house of Yahweh.

Do you know what's interesting...I just thought of something. We always say about fellow believers...well you can't judge me. And yet, are we going to say that when they are judging the world? Honestly, think about that. When you tell someone...you can't judge me...um, well they are going to judge you. I mean, do we even believe these scriptures? Do we even comprehend what they mean? You must be judged by the church. You must be willing to hold yourself accountable to the word that is through the church. The church is called the pillar and the ground of truth.

So brothers and sisters, we must be willing now to come under the jurisdiction of the church. We must be willing to come under authority of the word so that we can train for our future job. Unless Paul was just writing words that mean nothing, then we are getting ready to judge the world. Paul was so upset at them because they could not judge one another in the church. They couldn't discern one another. Paul was so good at discerning that even when a woman was praising the Lord, he cast the devil out of her.

So the point I'm making is we must learn to discern so that we can rule and reign in the coming kingdom of Yahweh. Whenever you say...no man can judge me... who do you think is going to judge the world? A bunch of men. Does anybody get that? Do you hear that men are going to judge men? But these men will no longer be men. They will have been transformed into the sons of Yahweh. Their minds will be transformed into the word of Yahweh.

Now, to get past all of this, we have to understand we are going to experience different levels of punishment and reward. Now what I just said is completely contrary to Christianity. Christianity says we all get the same thing—either hell or heaven. That's your two choices. The only problem with that is they disagree with Yahshua himself, and all of the word of God.

Your job today is to transform your thinking from being either/or. You must transform your thinking to what the word says. We're going to go now and find out what the word says. Let's go to Luke 10:10-16.

Now brother and sister, let me ask you before we read. If our only options are hell and heaven, and if the only thing we have to do to go to hell is to not believe in Christ, and the only thing we have to do to go to heaven is to believe in Christ, then there is no where to develop Christian character. Why would you even listen to a preacher like me who preaches that you must have works in your life?

Can I ask again? If your two options are hell and heaven, and the only thing you've got to do is believe or not believe, this message is anathema to your mind. You must understand Yahweh is going to give rewards and punishment in different degrees. And that's why you must live a life filled with good works.

Now if you don't believe what I'm saying, I don't blame you, I wouldn't either. But hopefully you will believe Yahshua himself.

Luke 10:10-16 10 But into whatsoever city ye enter, and they receive you not, go your ways out into the streets of the same, and say,

11 Even the very dust of your city, which cleaves on us, we do wipe off against you...

Now are they judging a city right there? Are men judging people right there? We do it against you. They made a judgment against that city. One day what I'm teaching is going to register with you. I don't know when, but one day it's going to register. One day you're going to understand your duty is to discern. That's why we're so hard on you about who to block, who to associate with. We're trying to teach you to discern so that you can judge adequately so that you can be counted worthy of the better resurrection so that you become a good judge. How many have ever heard the term...a judge of character? That's what a judge is. They are judging the character of the believer whether it lines up with the word or not.

...notwithstanding be ye sure of this, that the kingdom of Yahweh is come nigh unto you.

12 But I say unto you, that it shall be more tolerable in that day for Sodom, than for that city.

13 Woe unto thee, Chorazin! woe unto thee, Bethsaida! for if the mighty works had been done in Tyre and Sidon, which have been done in you, they had a great while ago repented, sitting in sackcloth and ashes.

14 But it shall be more tolerable for Tyre and Sidon at the judgment, than for you.

Now how is that? How is that if we're all getting the same punishment? What does "more tolerable" mean? *Get away with more*. There you go. I didn't say that you all, Yahshua did. So you're problem's not with me today. Your problem's with Yahshua. He said...First Harvest Ministries (I'm bringing it to our day), you know so much that there will be no tolerance for you. (I'm just going to let that percolate.)

He said...if they had known what you know, they would have all repented of their ignorance. He said for them I'm going to give them a lot more tolerance than I'm going to give First Harvest Ministries. Why? You know. For those that don't know, there is going to be a lesser degree of punishment at the judgment. But sister how can that be if our punishment is hell or heaven? I mean honestly saints all you've got to do is use your brain, that's all you've got to do.

15 And thou, Capernaum, which art exalted to heaven, shalt be thrust down to hell.

16 He that hears you hears me; and he that despises you despises me; and he that despises me despises him that sent me.

Do you all see a hierarchy there? I just saw a hierarchy. I just saw Father Yahweh represented in his son. I just saw his son represented in the overcomers, the bride. And you can't separate the three. That's what I just saw. Now you all have to get this because according to these scriptures, there is a group of people there will be no mercy for, and they're sitting in this room today, and there's many more scattered across the world. Why?

You alone have been called to this hour to walk in this light. They have not. Let me ask somebody real smart a question. Sister, let me ask you a question. This is something that we have to think about. If they had heard what you have heard they would have repented. If the Father knows that they would have repented had they been given the opportunity, and if he still sends them to hell, what's your opinion of that? *Yahweh is just and he would not do that*. Amen.

We serve a just God. So we know sister the only way those people he's referring to can be saved is through Yahshua the Messiah. Not because they didn't hear. In other words, you can't just be saved because you didn't hear. Ok? So if you must be saved through the son, and the Bible says you would've repented if you'd known, and you just said that Yahweh would never be that unjust, then what does that tell you sister just in your reasoning mind? *That there has got to be another* *day*. Hallelujah! Joy comes in the morning!! Amen. There's got to be another day. That day is the 8th day, the last great day of the feast. We will be teaching on that during the feast of Tabernacles. So brothers and sisters, joy is coming in the morning. You must become minsters of that message, and you must prepare yourself for what you're going to be doing during the 7th day.

Let's go to Luke 12:41, 47-48.

Luke 12:41, 47-48 41 Then Peter said to Him; Teacher, do You speak this parable only to us, or to everyone?

47 For that servant, who knew his ruler's will, but did not prepare nor act according to his will, will be beaten with many stripes.

48 And he who did not know, yet committed things worthy of stripes, will be beaten, yet less. But everyone to whom much is given, much will be required of him; and to whom much has been committed, from him will be more demanded.

Wow, that's a mic drop scripture. You don't even need to add anything to it. You don't have to say anything, it says everything. Here's what he said...there are no excuses for everyone in this room today. Look, a lot of people misunderstand. They think we believe that everybody's getting a second chance. No. No. There's no second chances. Every one gets an equal chance not a second chance.

Let me show you just how much there is no second chance for any one in this room after this life. I want to show you. Let's go to Hebrews 10:26 and then we'll go back to the scripture where we were just at.

Hebrews 10:26 For if we sin willfully after we have received the knowledge of the truth, there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins.

You're not getting a second chance darling. Do you know why? You've received the knowledge. Now let's take that scripture and read it in reverse. And let's see what the scripture is saying on what I call the flip side, what it doesn't say but what it's saying. If it says that for those who've received the knowledge of the truth there remains no more sacrifice for their sin, then it's also saying what? That those who've not received the knowledge of the truth, there still will remain a sacrifice for their sin. Glory to God. These are powerhouse scriptures. What did he just tell us in the parable we were just reading about? Let's go back there to Luke 12:41, 47-48. Here's what he just said to us. Read that last verse of 47-48 again.

Luke 12:47-48 47 For that servant, who knew his ruler's will...

Would that describe anybody in this room? Any servants who know your Father's will, the Torah? Yes. You know your Father's will. What he will have you to do. You don't have to pray about that, he left you his will. What about that servant?

...but did not prepare nor act according to his will...

Did not do what he knew to do. You see, your friends don't know about the Sabbath day. Your friends don't know the holy days. Your friend doesn't know who Yahshua is. So guess what? There is something that will apply to you that will not apply to them. If you don't get this, you will not understand the importance of this.

...will be beaten with many stripes.

Notice what it doesn't say. It doesn't say you're going to the lake of fire. There's no lake of fire anywhere here. You're going to be sent into punishment until you break your will. What is the purpose of many stripes? I don't know what it was for you all when you were children, but when I got an attitude, I lost it on about the third stripe. Amen? Did anybody ever get their attitude adjusted? Sometimes it took three stripes, maybe four. For me about the third one, I was ready to cry mercy.

Ok. This is you. If you don't submit to the will of Yahweh, he will make you submit in the coming judgment, or you can do it now in this judgment.

48 And he who did not know, yet committed things worthy of stripes, will be beaten, yet less. But everyone to whom much is given, much will be required of him...

Whatever is entrusted to you my friends is the degree to which Yahweh will expect of you. And that's a mouthful. Whatever has been given to you will be demanded to be lived out. *Well brother Vaughn, what about them?* See that's your problem. You don't know how this thing works. It was not given to them. As a matter of fact, go back and read verse 41 of the same chapter and listen, he is talking to his disciples, not to the church at large. Listen at what they ask him in verse 41.

41 Then Peter said to Him; Teacher, do You speak this parable only to us, or to everyone?

Ha ha! Do you see that? He's only revealing it to the bride. If the bride has received the knowledge and doesn't live it out, you will be punished more. Listen to me. If you know to keep the Sabbath and you don't keep it, you will be punished more than the one who goes to church on Sunday. Why? For whatever reasons beyond our understanding, Yahweh has granted this knowledge to you! He has a special calling on your life and now it's required of you. The more knowledge you have, the more accountability will be demanded and is being demanded of you.

Listen folks. I will be the first to tell you, I'm surprised I still have one of you still in this class after three years. Because this ministry ...no no, you don't join this... this joins you. You don't say...where do I sign up? You don't want to sign up for this. No, don't. It will sign you up if you're meant for it, ok? This is not an easy message. This is a message of whips and lashes on our backs so that we will surrender to his will. That's why you'll look on this screen right now and you'll see those who are no longer here. Like I said...I'm surprise any of you are. I'm surprised I'm still here! Everyday this message is breaking me more and more and more. Hallelujah! Thank you Father for the privilege of the stripes. Amen.

Every time you get a fresh understanding and you obey that understanding, guess what's going to come tomorrow? Even more understanding that you're going to have to walk in. If you don't want more, then don't obey what you've got, and the more will stop. Hallelujah. You'll get stuck just like the Baptists, the Pentecostals, Charismatics. They all get stuck in the last revelation of truth. But if you obey, you will get more. If you've ever wondered why this ministry keeps bringing you more, have you ever thought...my Lord what else is there to teach? What else is there left? And yet more keeps coming. Do you know why? Because we love what we get. We cherish it. We honor it. We love what we get! Amen? Praise Yahweh.

Are there any questions so far?

On the two resurrections, I had a verse that kept coming to my mind. It's in Revelation 8:1. When he opened the seventh seal there was silence in heaven about the space of 1/2 hour. In those two resurrections, to me, when the Christians come up in the second one, there's a time of silence around their deception and a shock for them. Yes, it's going to be a shock that's going to silence everything. You're right sister. Because I believe that will be the moment when the great deception will be exposed of Christianity. You know, when you think about 30 minutes of silence, have you ever been in a place where you just get shocked that you can't say anything? I really believe they're going to be like...*wait a minute, where's the pearly gates? Wait a minute, where's my mansion?* I believe it's going to be so shaking to them that...*why did we miss the rapture?* So forth and so on. You are exactly right sister.

Alright, you sister. *Pastor I realize this isn't for the faint of heart, but my question to you is: Romans 11:29 says the gifts and calling are without repentance. Is that what we're talking about why we're here now? We have what we're called to do?*

Yes ma'am. So the calling of God only goes to the called. There is no repentance for the called. Listen. When you hear this message...let's see there is a scripture that will line up with that. It says it would've been better if they'd never heard. Never mind there's so many of them there, but let's see.

2 Peter 2:21

For it had been better for them not to have known the way of righteousness, than, after they have known it, to turn from the holy commandment delivered unto them.

Do you know why? Because they're going to be beat with so many stripes now. It would've been better. How would've it been better for them not to know the way of the commandments? Notice it didn't say the way of salvation, but the way of the commandments. They would've been winked at in their ignorance. There you go because Yahweh didn't deliver it to them. But if he brought it to you, there is no repentance for that. The Bible said that any man that puts his hand to this plow. Now it didn't say that if any man that accepts Christ. It says that if any man that realizes there is work involved—the plow. What is the plow? Work! Any man that sees the message of the plow and looks back is not fit for the government. Amen?

Alright, let's move right along saints and let's get back into some of these other scriptures. My job today is to open your eyes to see the truth. Let's go now to the next one. Matthew 11:16-24

Matthew 11:16-24 16 But to what will I compare this generation? It is like children sitting in the marketplaces, calling to their friends,

Now I want you to listen to this carefully. Here's a parable. He's talking about this generation is like children, and listen to what he says in the next verse.

17 And saying: We played the flute for you, but you did not dance; we mourned to you, but you did not lament.

18 For John came neither eating nor drinking, and they say: He has a demon.

19 The Son of Man came eating and drinking, and they say; Behold, a gluttonous Man and a winebibber! A friend of publicans and sinners! But wisdom is justified by her children.

20 Then He began to denounce the cities in which most of His works of power were done, because they did not repent.

Alright, here was a group of people that had been revealed much more than the other cities had been revealed. He says you were like children...I played a flute for you, but you did not dance to the music. I played a flute for you and you wouldn't dance. In other words, you didn't come to the party. I brought you the party. The party of truth, I brought it to you. But you wouldn't obey it.

In other words, the rules say when you hear the flute, you do what? You start dancing. When you hear the truth, you start living it. You're like children, you don't want to obey.

21 Woe to you, Chorazin! Woe to you, Bethsaida! For if the works of power which were done in you had been performed in Tyre and Sidon long ago, they would have repented in sackcloth and ashes!

22 But I say to you: It will be more tolerable for Tyre and Sidon at the day of judgment, than for you!

23 And Capernaum, who are exalted to heaven, you will be brought down to Sheol, the grave!

Listen. Notice where they're not going to be brought down to. The lake of fire. Because the wages of their sin is death, the grave. Their final destination according to Yahshua is not the lake of fire. It is the grave. "You've been exalted to the heavens. I've given you more knowledge and understanding than anyone, but you're going to wind up in eternal death because you have rejected, you did not dance to the flute".

I hope I can turn all of you into dancers. When you hear the flute, start dancing. Hallelujah. When you hear the fluty toot of the word, when you hear a song of truth come out, start dancing to the truth. Amen.

For if the works of power which were done in you had been performed in Sodom, it would have remained until this day.

24 But I say to you: It will be more tolerable for the land of Sodom in the day of judgment, than for you!

Amen. Let's go to Mark 4:21. So I just want to ask you right now on the subject of tolerable judgment, different levels of judgment. Does anybody have a question specifically or is there any argument against this that you can make? There are different degrees of judgment and rewards. And without that understanding beloved, you will never be an overcomer. Why? Why do you want to be an overcomer? What's the point? Does that make sense to you guys? What's the point? Amen. Alright.

Mark 4:21 He said to them: Is a lamp brought to be put under a basket or under a bed, and not on a lamp stand?

What you hear, and how you handle what you hear. Here's what he said. "Do you think I brought you this light for you not to live it, to show it, to let it come through you? Do you think I brought you this truth so you can go tell all your neighbors how smart you are now?" No.

"Do you think I did this to make you know more than the other Christians know?" No. "I brought you this light so that you will set this light on a lamp stand, and you will live this light, you will walk the way, the original way, you will walk it out to where other Christians can see you that don't have this light."

Let's read Hebrews 10:28-30.

Hebrews 10:28-30 28 He that despised Moses' law died without mercy under two or three witnesses:

Listen, listen. He that despised or rejected Moses' law died without mercy. Do you know what that just told me? There's some people who are going to die with mercy. Did you all just hear what the scripture said without saying it? That's how I read my Bible. When the Bible says something I stop and say, wait a minute. If those that despised Moses' law died without mercy, then there had to be somebody that died with mercy. Amen. Keep reading.

29 Of how much sorer punishment, suppose ye, shall he be thought worthy, who hath trodden under foot the Son of God, and hath counted the blood of the covenant, wherewith he was sanctified, an unholy thing, and hath done despite unto the Spirit of grace?

Well, see you've got grace and now you don't need any works. You have just disgraced grace. You have trampled on grace. I don't think anybody heard that verse really. Let's read that again and I want everybody to <u>read</u> it.

How much sorer punishment? Now here's my question. If we're all going to the same lake of fire, how does one have a sorer punishment than the other? Read...

29 How much more severely do you think a man deserves to be punished, who has trampled the Son of Yahweh underfoot, and has counted the blood of the covenant (with which He was sanctified) an unholy thing, and who has insulted the Spirit of mercy?

Brother Vaughn, I've been saved by the blood, I'm good to go. No, you've insulted the blood. You've trampled on the blood because you didn't maintain good works that lines up with what the blood is supposed to do in your life. You have literally walked on the blood while saying that you claim the blood. You have crucified Yahshua all over again because you're so...*I love the blood.*

Brothers and sisters, if you love the blood, you'll live the life of the crucified way. The blood is the crucified way! I don't know if there's a next verse but I bet it's good if there is.

30 For we know Him Who has said: Vengeance is Mine; I will repay, says Yahweh. And again: Yahweh will judge His people.

Now there you go brothers and sisters. You will be judged by trampling on the blood, by disgracing grace, by talking about the blood without letting the blood talk through you. That light on a candlestick.

Alright. So I had to spend an hour to show you from the word that everybody's not getting the same punishment or the same reward. Is that settled so far

because I haven't even started my lesson, ha ha! Do we have that part settled? Alright. Now let's go talk about some good stuff! Hallelujah.

The Law of Jubilee Explained

Let's go to Leviticus 25:54. You're about to learn about the Law of Jubilee. I want everyone to learn this law of Jubilee.

We're talking about slaves here. Slaves to sin, slaves to Egypt. So here's the way it worked. According to Torah, you lived in the land of Israel and you owned real estate. Every one in Israel had a land inheritance. Yahweh loves real estate. Every man received a piece of land as an Israelite. That was their natural birthright.

But let's say he goes through life and he owes so much money to people that he loses that land through poverty and debt. Now he becomes a slave or a servant to whoever he owes money to. That's why you all are servants to sin. You owe sin. You've enjoyed it's pleasures and now you owe it.

So he would have to go to work for whoever he owed the debt to. He would lose the land, alright? That land would go to his master. But according to the law of Jubilee, no matter how far he went in debt, he would always return unto his land inheritance at the end of the 50-year Jubilee cycle. At the Jubilee everyone's debts were cancelled and every man was given his inheritance.

Now, you and I were given an inheritance through Adam. What was that inheritance? That we should rule the earth. That's our inheritance. Our father Adam was given the earth. Now brother and sisters we have lost that inheritance through our debt to sin. That's why Satan is still the Lord of this earth. That's why Satan has the land. I need everybody to hear me now.

This land was given. It was told to Adam...this is yours, take it, obtain it from Satan. We did not do that. We did not get our inheritance. Our inheritance is still in the hands of Satan. That's why he's the god of this earth, this is his earth. Every one of you owe a debt and he is holding your inheritance until the debt is paid.

Now I want to talk to you about when that debt is going to be paid. Let's go read Leviticus 25:54.

Leviticus 25:54 Even if he is not redeemed in any of these years and by these ways...

Ok I want you to hear that first line. Let me break this down for you. Let's say you lost your land. Oh this is so powerful I'm about to catch the Holy Ghost! Listen! I taught you last week you could have a kinsmen redeemer. If you lost your land, you could have kin folk come and do what? Redeem you. They would pay to get the land back.

That's what Yahshua did for you brothers and sisters. Yahshua is near kinsmen, he's a man just like you. He went and paid the debt and you and those of us who are being converted, have been given our inheritance back, alright? Everyone listen to me. But, according to this verse we're going to read, if there is any man at the Jubilee who did not have a redeemer—if any man did not get the call to salvation, didn't know Yahshua, never heard about him, didn't know the gospel, did not claim the blood, did not receive Yahshua as his Messiah—if there's any man when the Jubilee comes...I want you to read what happens to that man.

...he and his children are to be released in the Year of Jubilee.

Whew!! Hallelujah! If you didn't know the Redeemer, you will meet him at the Jubilee! Him and his children. Joy comes in the morning! The morning is the Jubilee! The millennial reign is the Jubilee that is coming to the whole. I love that. Him and all his children will be released from the debt. That's why Satan will be bound, to release the inheritance back to all the sons of Adam!!! Glory to Yahweh!!

You've got to get this message. You've got to understand what you believe. We believe in the Jubilee. We are Torah-observant. What does that mean? Our doctrines must line up with the Torah! Anything that Yahweh has done he what? Will do. Anything that's ever been will be. The Torah is for our example, for our understanding of not what was, but what is to come. The Torah is replicating itself over and over! Glory! When you get this Jubilee message, you'll understand that joy comes in the morning. And you'll be working on yourself.

Now hold on. You've got a redeemer. That verse doesn't apply to you. You've got a redeemer. You're already seated together with him in heavenly places. Hallelujah. You've already got your inheritance. Hallelujah! You've already got your inheritance!! You've already been given your authority over the earth, and over your earth, and your addictions and over your temptations. You've been given power by the Redeemer to take it all back.

Our kinsmen redeemer came and we found out we were free, but they are not. Your family won't walk in this light. They don't know their kinsmen redeemer. For those men, them and their children, the debt will be released from them at the Jubilee which is the millennial reign. Why? Because the man that's holding the mortgage will disappear, the mortgage will be released.

Now brothers and sisters, that's why so few Bible teachers understand what the scroll is with the seven seals in the book of Revelation. I listen to people trying to explain that scroll and I want to cry. Because they don't know what that scroll is. Do you all remember, do I need to read it—the scroll and the hand of Yahweh, he's holding the scroll? And there's seven seals on that scroll? And John is weeping because no man can open the scroll? Do you know what the scroll is?

If you go read Torah, anytime there was a mortgage or a deed to property, it was always sealed with seven seals. Brothers and sisters, John was weeping because your inheritance was still bound up. Your legal mortgage was still on your property. But Yahshua came and broke those seals and gave you your deed back to the inheritance of the sons of Yahweh! You are now restored to your authority over the earth! Written in that scroll is the deed to the earth! Glory!

And John was weeping because he knew that if somebody didn't release the seals, if somebody didn't pay the debit, what was inside would never be given back to the sons of Adam! But he said...behold, look, there comes the Lamb, the Lion of the tribe of Judah to open the seals and to return it to the sons of Adam! That is a picture of the JUBILEE !!!

Notice when it happens, after the seventh trumpet, that's when the seals are open. The coming kingdom of God will open the seals to the mortgage to planet earth. Planet earth is under a mortgage. That's why creation is weeping and groaning and travailing, praying to God that the sons of Yahweh will finally grow up and claim that mortgage to be debt free in the Jubilee year at the resurrection! Whoo! My, my, my, my. Hallelujah. If you don't understand this, my, my, no wonder people want to go to heaven—they don't understand the Jubilee.

But he did find somebody worthy, and I'll tell you what, it wasn't a "God" or an angel. He said a man. I found a man who was worthy to open those seals. Hallelujah. Oh hallelujah! Oh! To me this message gives more glory to Yahshua than the old message we believed. This message gives him more glory and honor that a man was able to open the seals! Hallelujah. Glory. And I know some other men who's going to take that mortgage out of his hand when we arrest Satan and put him under our feet. We'll say...here is the deed! Here is the deed to the sons of Adam!! Glory. Glory!

The sons of Yahweh are going to take that deed because we can't arrest Satan unless it's legal. We've got to show his mortgage debt is cancelled by the blood of Yahshua and we have come to take it all back, put him under our feet, and then Yahshua will turn around and give it all back to his Father so that Yahweh may be all in all!! Oh blessed be the name of the Lord! I'm looking forward to that day. I'm looking forward to when joy comes in the morning! The Jubilee is almost here!! Whew, for some of us it's already come. Hallelujah. For some of us Jubilee's already come. For the rest of the men who didn't have a redeemer, it's still to come. Oh blessed be the name of Yahweh. Hallelujah. I feel the Holy Spirit. Blessed be your name Father. Blessed be your name. Glory, glory, glory, glory!

Somebody said...*brother Vaughn's over there teaching the law, teaching bondage bringing people back to the law.* Darling, I teach grace to a level you haven't ever heard grace preached before. We are a grace church, do you understand me? We believe in a grace your Baptist church has no idea about. We believe in a freedom for all men. We believe in a release for all the inhabitants of the earth!! We believe in a grace you can't comprehend!! Hallelujah!! Whew! Don't let anybody tell you we don't believe in grace! We believe in grace to the highest level! Glory to God. Hallelujah.

Oh, but we believe there's got to be a set of sons walking in obedience to bring that ultimate grace to pass for the whole world! Glory to God! Now tell me your struggle isn't worth it. Now tell me your persecution isn't worth it. Now tell me what your going through isn't worth it! KNOW WHO YOU ARE!! And don't ever let go of it. Don't ever let go of who you are. Hallelujah. Oh nobody in your house may know who you are, but you better know who you are! I said, nobody in your family may know who you are, but you better know who you are. Otherwise you might not be able to endure it. Hallelujah!

Go ahead sister. Yeah the difference between the grace you're preaching and what the modern day Christian church preaches—they believe in a fluffy grace, that love is love, and just be a little nicer, be a little kinder. There's a difference in the grace of Yahweh compared with what they preach. They've got a new age grace. Yeah my problem with their grace is it sounds just like liberals, the liberals and the democrat type grace.

Amen. Let's continue real quickly so we can get through this. No man can go so far in debt that he cannot be redeemed by grace in the end. The Jubilee not only allows it, but the Jubilee actually demands it. This will be the grace like you've never seen before. We know there are many who have not appropriated the redemptive grace of Jesus. What is to become of them? Are they doomed to remain in bondage to the master of sin forever? No.

The law has a statute of limitations on sin and debt bondage. I want you to hear me. Every law has a statute of limitations. And the law of sin and death has a

statute of limitations. Hallelujah, it's the Jubilee! And it's hold on you will be released in the Jubilee. Praise Yahweh, let's continue.

This is the law of grace. It is manifested and demanded by the law of Jubilee, so that even if they are not redeemed during those years of servitude, they must be set free at the Jubilee purely by an act of grace. This is an outrageous statement to those who have been taught that God will punish men without end and without any hope of a final redemption.

It is ironic that those who believe in grace at the expense of the law of God are less merciful in their outlook toward sinners than those who know the law of Jubilee and how it establishes true grace.

Did you hear what I just said? Those who claim to preach grace, they say that we preach law. But because we preach law, we know about a grace that they know nothing about. Hallelujah. I hope you caught that. It's because we know Torah that we know about ultimate grace. Oh thank God for this truth.

Listen to me beloved. We believe in grace. We just don't believe in abusing grace. This ministry teaches that there's a grace coming that some of your mind's can't comprehend that type of grace. Hallelujah. Let's continue.

Paul knew about the law of Jubilee and he wrote that all of creation is groaning in travail awaiting the manifestation of the sons of God. All creation lives in hope for the Great Jubilee of creation. All of creation is going to be set free from the debt note, from the mortgage. They're all going to be released from the law of sin and death.

That's why the Bible said that the last enemy to be defeated by Yahshua is what? Death. Because the mortgage still demands death. But once the mortgage is no longer over the property then death is no longer going to be in control. What a message this is!
